## Criteria

- Presentations must be either 30 or 60 minutes in length.
- All presentations are recorded and shared via Child's Play YouTube channel post event.
- Presentations must not attempt to sell products.

## Steps to Submit

- Visit [childsplaycharity.org/symposium](https://childsplaycharity.org/symposium)
- The Association of Child Life Professionals reviews the final event agenda and determines the number of continuing education credits awarded. Submissions must include:
  - Summary of presentation/Relevance/Applicability to pediatric gaming and technology
  - Learning Objectives: For continuing education credits provide at least three to five learning objectives that are clear, measurable, and achievable
  - Detailed Abstract

## Review Process

The Pediatric Gaming and Technology Symposium committee evaluates each proposal for content quality, relevance to attendees, and alignment with committee priorities. Selection will also be based on conference program agenda space and the need to curate diversified content.

## Notification of Acceptance

Deadline: Proposals must be sent to Child's Play through the online submission process, open now through – August 1, 2026. The primary presenter listed on the submission will be notified via email of the acceptance or declination of their presentation submission by August 30, 2026.
